## Frequently asked questions

**What are the camp hours?** 9:00 A.M. – 2:00 P.M. (Monday through Thursday | 9:00 A.M. – 7:30 P.M. (Friday; day of performance)

**Where will SPOTLIGHT camp be held?** John S. Burd Center for the Performing Arts on the campus of Brenau University 429 ACADEMY STREET NE, GAINESVILLE GA 30501

Where will the Friday evening performance be held? HOSCH THEATRE housed within the John S. Burd Center for the Performing Arts on the campus of Brenau University 429 ACADEMY STREET NE, GAINESVILLE GA 30501

**How much does SPOTLIGHT camp cost?** \$200 (includes t-shirt and performance materials)

**How much will the Friday evening performance cost?** Adults \$5 plus tax | Under 18 years of age \$2 plus tax

What will we need to bring the first day of camp? Registration forms must be completed and returned to the Quinlan at least one week prior to SPOTLIGHT camp. Forms are available on our website at <a href="www.qvac.org">www.qvac.org</a>. A brief <a href="mandatory">mandatory</a> parent/guardian orientation will be held in the lobby of the Jogn S. Burd Center for the Performing Arts (Brenau University) at 9:00 A.M. on the first day of camp. Parents/guardians will receive all necessary information concerning SPOTLIGHT, at that time.

My child is not keen being on stage and would prefer working with sets, lighting, design, costuming, etc. Is this camp for her/him? YES! While all campers will be introduced to all aspects of putting together a performance, we will have campers run the entire performance. This means lighting, set design and executive, costuming, make-up, etc. will also be done by campers. All campers will be in the SPOTLIGHT based on their interests. We will have a performance photo wall in the lobby and all campers will have time being acknowledged and celebrated.

Will my child need to bring lunch & snacks? Yes. Send a sack lunch and snack every day that do not require refrigeration. Students have a mid-morning snack time and lunchtime (see daily schedule). We request that snacks be low in sugar. A water fountain is always available. Please label lunches, snacks and drinks to avoid mix-ups and confusion. The students will be provided with a pizza dinner before the performance.

What should my child wear? Campers should wear old, comfortable, cool clothes to camp as well as <u>tennis shoes</u>. Clothing should allow movement/dance. Please be aware that this is an ARTS camp, and students will be "creative" with a lot of different media. Clothing may get dirty with paint, etc.

Where do I pick them up? Camp ends each day at 2:00 P.M. (Monday through Thursday). Please turn into the Burd Center driveway (on the right side of building if looking at it from the front), drive around the back and start the carpool line on the left of the building. Your student will come to your car once released by an instructor. Cars should line up <u>no earlier</u> than 1:45 PM. If you need to pick up your camper early, please park your car in a parking area and come into the building to get your child. Please call 770.536.2575 in the event of an emergency. Late pick-ups will incur an aftercare fee of \$20 for the first 15 minutes, and for each 15 minutes after. Campers must have written permission to ride home with someone other than a parent or alternate persons indicated on registration form.

Will my camper stay at camp the entire time listed on the day of the performance? Yes, your camper will be at camp from 9:00 A.M. to 7:30 P.M. on Friday. We will have camp and rehearsals up until performance time. They will of course get breaks throughout. A pizza dinner will be provided for all campers on Friday.

How are class groups determined? Classes are divided by grades: rising 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>; rising 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, and rising 7<sup>th</sup> graders.

Can my child bring a friend? Yes! \$50 per child per day. However, the guest student will not be included in the culminating performance on Friday. Guests should be in the same age group as the participating camper. Classes are geared to specific age groups to ensure the best experience for everyone. Please give instructors advance notice at least ONE day before the guest attends and be sure to fill out the **Registration Forms**.

What is the cancellation/transfer policy for summer camp? <u>Camp is non-refundable.</u> Since SPOTLIGHT is only offered this particular week during the summer, there are no transfers available.

**Is the public welcome to the performance?** Yes, all are welcome to the performance on Friday evening. The performance will last approximately 45 minutes. Tickets for the performance are available on QVAC.org. Campers will need to stay behind to strike down the stage. Campers will be released to parents/guardians at 7:30 P.M. Family and friends will have an opportunity to meet campers immediately, post-performance.
