SUPPLIES:

Pencils Required:

2H, HB, 3B, 6B

Ruler: 18 inch metal cork backed ruler

Eraser: Plastic (vinyl-magic rub by Faber-Castel or equivalent brand plastic eraser)

Erasing Shield: Metal type approximately 2 ½ by 3 inches

Tortillions: (Paper stumps) Twisted paper usually gray in color for blending and shading.

Sketch Paper or Drawing Pad: Good Grade Strathmore or Bristol paper, somewhat rough with bite for the pencil.

Sandpaper Pad or Medium Sandpaper Sheet

Masking Tape

Drawing Board 18 x 24 inches or cardboard to tape paper to when sketching

Pencil Holders if desired to hold short pencils for their full usages (optional)

Traingles, T- square or circle templates (optional)
