The husband and wife team of Krisztina Wajsza and Benjamin Bunch are presenting a program of music by composers from Brazil, France and Spain. These include Heitor Villa-Lobos from Brazil, who died fifty years ago, to Isaac Albéniz, from Spain, who died one hundred years ago. Also represented are Claude Debussy, Maurice Ravel, Manuel de Falla and Enrique Granados.

Krisztina Wajsza hails from Transylvania, Romania, and Benjamin Bunch from Transylvania County, North Carolina ! Ms Wajsza studied at the Julliard School of Music in New York and at Indiana University in Bloomington. Mr. Bunch pursued his studies at the North Carolina School of the Arts in Winston-Salem and at the Music Academy in Basel, Switzerland, where he and his wife teach.

Both musicians have performed extensively in Europe and have toured South America and the United States. Each performs as a soloist and with various ensembles and orchestras. They have recorded for radio and television in several countries on three continents. Mr. Bunch has released three CD's with others in the planning.

The Wajsza Bunch family have two daughters, Anthea (12) and Alycia-May (16 months), and reside in Basel, Switzerland.
