Painting the Still Life: Oil Painting Fundamentals for Beginners. Ann Goble

Our first day of class will focus on oil paint materials, their function, preparing the canvas, preparing the palette. I've tried to include information to ease the supply ordering process, but if you have questions, please call me at 770-532-0110. We will not use all the materials on the first day, for example you will not need all the pigments or brush sizes until week 3. I have put an asterisk beside the items needed for the first 2 weeks, but sometimes it is easier to just order everything at once. Whichever way you want to do it is fine. **Also, if you have other brands or types of the items listed, please feel free to use them instead, except for the mineral spirits- Gamsol is required.**

*Binders may not have all of the items listed but they can help you choose from similar options.

***Gamsol:** Odorless Mineral Spirits for brush cleaning and toning canvas. This is the only brand acceptable for a safe studio environment.

***Container for Gamsol/metal brush washer:** I suggest the Newton Air-Tight Delux Brush Washer, \$25.00 (on sale at Jerry's, item # 53189). There are plenty of less expensive options but the Newton Washer will last forever, won't spill and is much easier to use.

***Primer:** Golden Gesso White, 8 oz. jar (Jerry's item #48967, \$7.67)

I prefer Art Spectrum Oil Prime but it is pricey at \$17.00 for a 500ml. can (Jerry's #62379) so you may want to start with the Golden Gesso.

***Canvas:** Prices vary greatly depending on quality. Start with a cotton stretched canvas or board such as the Winsor Newton Artists' Canvas Universal Twin Packs for a good, economical canvas, in sizes 8x10, 9x12, and 11x14 (Jerry's # V00284, # V00285, # V00286), or anything similar. If not buying the twin packs, buy 2 of each size.

***Palette Box:** Masterson Air-Tight Palette- Artists Palette Seal (Jerry's item #13483, \$12.48). Also, available at most art supply stores.

***Medium:** Gamblin Neo-Meglip, 8 oz. bottle (Jerry's item #61588, \$11.59)

Oil Brushes:

***Hog Bristle Brushes, filberts** #2, # 4, #6, #8, #10, good quality only, such as Silver Brand, or Winsor Newton Lexington Series (more affordable)

Soft Sable, #0 round, #6 flat. Winsor Newton Eclipse Black Sable is a good choice (#69824, #69812 Jerry's)

***Palette Knife**, medium size

From Lowe's or Home Depot:

*Piece of glass or plexiglas, 12x16- this will fit into the plastic palette box

*Paint Brush for priming- 2 inch, basic

Paint Scraper, razor blade type, inexpensive

Toolbox for your supplies, inexpensive, lightweight, medium size.

Other:

*Bar of Ivory Soap in baggie or soap container

*Roll of absorbent paper towels

*Apron or paint shirt

Oil Paint:

No student grade paint; make sure you are purchasing the artist grade! Please purchase quality brands such as Winsor Newton Artists' (not Winton), Holbein, Grumbacher, Rembrandt or Gamblin. As you gain more experience you will want to venture into even finer brands but for now these are perfectly good. I find that Grumbacher has the most reasonable prices. To help you with price and brand, I have put in parentheses my suggestion for brand and best price.

Size: 37ml

Permalba White (150 ml)

Permanent Alizarin Crimson (Gamblin)

Yellow Ochre (Gamblin)

Ultramarine Blue Dark (Holbein), 40 ml.

Naples Yellow Light (Winsor Newton Artists')

Cadmium Yellow Medium (Grumbacher)

Cadmium Red Medium (Grumbacher)

Cadmium Orange (Grumbacher)

Cobalt Blue (Grumbacher)

Viridian (Grumbacher)

***Burnt Umber (Grumbacher)**

***Transparent Oxide Red (Grumbacher) Buy 2 tubes, or one large**

******I know this list of supplies may be a bit overwhelming, but to learn to paint, you need good materials and this endeavor should be the beginning of a lifetime of painting for you! So invest in the good stuff, if you can!**
