A French term from the Italian *basso-relievo* ("low relief"), **bas relief** is a sculpture technique in which figures and/or other design elements are just barely more prominent than the (overall flat) background.

For any beginner age 11 to 111, you will be creating a 4x4 to 6x6 tile using waxed base clay. Attention will be given to textures. Each student will leave with a re-usable mold and a hydro stone cast of their relief. Supply list available on website.
