

The Art League – Quinlan Visual Arts Center  
Exhibition Rules

**Place:** Quinlan Visual Arts Center, downstairs in the studio hallway

**Submission dates:** to be announced

**Entry Fees:** \$10.00 for up to three works of art, done in the last two years, and not previously shown at the Quinlan.

**Eligibility:** Members of the Art League who are also members of the Quinlan

Paintings: oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel, mixed media, drawings, graphics, serigraphs

Sculpture and crafts: weaving, pottery, enamel, jewelry, glasswork

Photography

**Works must be original:** Original implies its definition. Please no copies of magazine photos or other works in print, including advertising. If work is done from a photo, the photo must be that of the artist ( or used with the permission of the photographer). No works from commercial molds or decoupage are permitted.

**All works should be of highest quality and in good taste.**

**Size:** If a work is over 48 inches, the artist is limited to one piece, because of limited hanging space.

**Framing:** All framed work MUST be wired for hanging (securely and not too tightly). No sawtooth hangers will be allowed. Wrap-around canvases must be stapled on the back with side edges painted. All works on paper must be matted or floated and protected by glass or plexiglass. The following are unacceptable: bracket-held glass, sawtooth hangers, slipping wire brackets, side-stapled canvases without frames. Please be sure your frame is in excellent shape – no chips or broken corners.

**Identify artwork on the back:**

Artist's name

Title of work

Medium

Price – Artist must set the value of his/her own work – or set forth NFS (not for sale) – the Quinlan Gift shop will handle all sales, with 40% of sale going to the Quinlan Visual Arts Center and 60% going to the artist.

**Note:** Work should remain at the Quinlan for the duration of the show (two months), unless sold. Work accepted may only hang once at the Quinlan.

**Awards:** A different judge will be announced for each show and will choose the paintings that will hang in the show and will give the awards for the show. First Place will be awarded \$50 and a blue ribbon. Second Place – red ribbon, Third Place – White ribbon, Honorable Mention – up to 5 can be awarded – with green ribbon. Any artist is eligible to receive more than one award in the same show. Award ribbons become the property of the artist and will be placed on the award-winning work for the duration of the show.

**Miscellaneous:** All work submitted for the show that has not been accepted, should be picked up within one week. Any work rejected in a show may be submitted in any future show. Winners will be announced at the monthly meeting following the judging of the artwork.
