## **QUINLAN YOUTH ART MONTH GUIDELINES**

Dear Teachers,

Due to the overwhelming participation at the 2012 Quinlan Visual Arts Center Youth Art Month competition, the following recommendations will ensure that your students will be presented at the 2013 Youth Art Month competition. Because of the sheer volume of entries, we are no longer able to contact individual teachers, students or parents to correct mistakes or omissions. In order for our intake process to work efficiently, PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THE GUIDELINES.

- All two dimensional artwork must be <u>ready to hang</u>. Framing is always preferred; however, if it is unframed, please make sure that you have an installation system in place. Unmounted and unframed prints are **NOT** considered ready to hang and will be immediately removed from the exhibition.
- All artwork **MUST** have both an art entry form attached to the piece <u>and</u> **ONE** copy submitted to the Quinlan Visual Arts Center.
- Incomplete paperwork will result in immediate elimination from the exhibition. Any student under the age of 18 that does not have signed parental consent will be removed from the exhibition.
- Please keep in mind that we install all art work based on the information provided. Art entry form orientation on the back of artwork should indicate the direction the art should be hung. Please indicate any special instructions on the paperwork attached to the piece. If hanging mechanisms do not correspond with the direction of the art entry form, teacher assumes responsibility for any incorrectly installed work.
- There are no rules against multiple entries per student, however, please keep in mind that there is a limited amount of space. Please encourage your students to **edit wisely**. If the exhibition continues to grow and we continue to see 10 or more pieces submitted for a single student, there may be limitations placed in the future. Please be courteous of the other competitors.

1<sup>st</sup> place \$2,500 2<sup>nd</sup> place \$1,500 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$1,000

The scholarships will be awarded in the same manner as the Kiwanis District Scholarship Awards. Upon the student's enrollment to college, he/she will notify the Kiwanis Club of Gainesville, and a check will be sent directly to the school.

The scholarship winners in the Performing, Visual and Writing Arts will be honored at the **Kiwanis Club of Gainesville Awards Luncheon, scheduled for noon on May 7**<sup>th</sup> **at the Elk's Club.**During the luncheon, the winning artists, "Best of Show" from the Visual Arts Showcase will display their artwork, and the scholarship winners from the Performing Arts Showcase perform their pieces and the scholarship winners from the Writing Showcase will read their works. *The instructors and parents of the scholarship winners are invited to the luncheon.*

# Charles J. Thurmond Youth Art Scholarship Awards Kiwanis Club of Gainesville's Visual Arts Showcase

The Kiwanis Club of Gainesville invites the students of your school to participate in the **2013 Kiwanis Visual Arts Showcase**. This competition provides an opportunity for *middle and high school students* to receive county and statewide recognition for their artwork. In addition, this is an opportunity for local high school students to win scholarship funds to help finance their college education!

The artwork of all participants will be on display at **The Quinlan Art Center** during the competition. The reception which will be held Friday March 15<sup>th</sup>. The Kiwanis Awards Luncheon will recognize and award the three scholarship winners, "**Best of Show**" awards only. The Kiwanis Awards Luncheon is scheduled for noon May 7<sup>th</sup> at the Elks Club.

#### **General Rules for Contestants**

- 1. All contestants must be students in good standing with their respective school/home school organization and currently registered in **middle or high school**.
- 2. Work in the following media will be accepted: painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, sculpture, metal work, graphic design, mixed media and crafts.
- 3. A contestant may not win more than one award.
- The completed application is to be submitted with the artwork upon delivery by Thursday, March 7<sup>th</sup> to The Quinlan Art Center.

At the county level, the following scholarships will be awarded for *Best of Show*, for 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade artists only:

1° place	\$2,500
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	\$1,500
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	\$1,000

Scholarships awarded at the County Competition, as well as the State Competition, will be presented in the form of a check issued to a college or university of the student's choice.

The top four artists from each grade will receive ribbons which will be awarded at the reception and awards ceremony at the Quinlan Arts Center on Friday, March 15<sup>th</sup> from 5:30-7:00pm. The three scholarship winners and their instructors will be recognized and awards will be presented at the Kiwanis Awards Luncheon on May 7<sup>th</sup> at noon at the Elks Club. Parents of the scholarship winners are also invited to the Kiwanis Awards Luncheon. The winning artwork will be on display at the Awards Luncheon.

The 1<sup>st</sup> place students from each grade, and an honorable mention contestant, will be submitted as entrants in the state competition. At the state competition, The Kiwanis Memorial Foundation is providing \$5000 in scholarship awards to the *Best of Show* winners. As in the county competition, scholarships awarded to the winning artists by the Foundation will be presented in

the form of a check issued to a college or university of the winning artist's choice. In addition, ribbons will also be awarded to the artists from each grade placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and honorable mention at the state and county competitions.
