DONNA CATOTTI

(b. 1950, Vermont)

As a young child I became intrigued with painting, regularly admiring William Adolphe Bouguereau's classical painting "Nymphs and Satyr" at the Sterling Clarke Museum in my father's hometown in Massachusetts. This large painting mesmerized me, and I, a paint-by-number kid, wished I could paint like that. I have never lost my fascination with this artist, nor with the portrait/figure genre.

As a young adult I went from fashion design in NYC to architecture school where I earned a Bachelor of Design from the University of Florida in 1973, to several years of freelance commercial art, to my first fine art gallery show the year I turned 30. The architecture degree included lots of perspective, drawing and painting, abstract and compositional design. Life drawing was chosen as an elective, and I have pursued models, skeletons, anatomy books, and classes ever since. The human form is so endlessly challenging and intriguing, that it is often the focus of my work. Currently working in oils, pastels, serigraphy, and sculpture, many subjects interest me. I prefer to work from life, whether indoors or out. Much of my professional work has expressed my love of wilderness and nature.

In 1983, I studied with Theodore Lukits at his studio in LA and have since taken numerous workshops at Scottsdale Artists School, Studio Incamminati and others. As Alaska State Ambassador for the Portrait Society of America, I attend their educational conferences and curate member shows in the state. Organizing a local life-drawing group in the winter, I also host Studio Incamminati instructors each summer for portrait/figure painting workshops in Haines, Alaska where I live.

Haines is one of the prettiest places on the planet and is where my artist/luthier husband, Rob Goldberg, and I have chosen to handcraft our home/studios and gardens from the forest, surrounded by mountains, ocean, and inspiration. We have two boys adopted from Bulgaria where we have traveled many times.

Since 2013, I have been actively entering numerous competitions with success, winning a spot in the Artists Magazine "Over 60" competition that year, and participating in yearly shows at the National Arts and Salmagundi Clubs in NYC, as well as shows with American Women Artists, Scottsdale Artists School, Richeson 75 shows, Pastel Society of America and other pastel groups, including PSWC and SPS.

Eight years and 40 entries later, I am delighted to be juried into my first OPA show at the Quinlan Visual Arts Center and sorry that I am unable to attend the event. My painting, "Circa 1703 – Elsfreth Alley" was painted after an on-location color study done in Philadelphia on a 45 degree April day. The class I

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had signed up for got canceled after I had purchased my plane ticket, so I decided to spend the week plein air painting in the city. This painting was also juried into the Catharine Lorillard Wolfe Art Club 123rd Open Exhibition at the National Arts Club in NYC in 2020, as well as into the Scottsdale Artists School's 2021 Best and Brightest Show, and the 8th Annual Booth Art Guild Show at the Booth Western Art Museum in Cartersville, GA.
