Lee Anne White is a fine art photographer who creates intimate portraits of place—the landscape, plants and indigenous details that give it character. Her work has been exhibited nationally in both solo and group shows, including 30 photographs on permanent display at Brenau University. She sells prints through her website, galleries, interior designers and art consultants. And she teaches landscape photography workshops in Coastal Maine, Santa Fe, the Apostle Islands and Amelia Island.

She previously served as the editor of *Fine Gardening* magazine and consulting editor for Taunton Books—authoring or editing and photographing nearly 20 books on garden design and landscape architecture. She also photographed more than 75 magazine feature stories for *Fine Gardening*, *Organic Gardening*, *Landscape Architecture*, *Garden Design*, *Kitchen Garden*, *Better Homes and Gardens*, *Country Gardens*, *Country Living* and *Atlanta Homes & Lifestyles* and others. She earned a master's degree in creative studies at the State University of New York/Buffalo State and a bachelor's degree in journalism, broadcasting and commercial art at The Women's College of Brenau University. She lives in Gainesville, Georgia.

I am fascinated by the beauty, essence and changing complexion of landscapes. I enjoy them most in the quiet moments—in the soft light of sunrise and sunset, on winter days when trees bare their bones, and on foggy mornings when less is visible and the world doesn't seem quite so complicated. Whether natural, designed or cultural landscapes, I enjoy exploring them over time, finding the 'fingerprints' that give them character and capturing a sense of place. I also have a passion for plants and other natural objects, and often gather them on walks or travels to bring back to my studio to study and photograph.
